## Tier 2 Public Notice April 4, 2022

- \*On March 3, 2022, during the State of Colorado's inspection of the District, the inspec-tor determined that Ralston Valley had not met the annual backflow assembly testing ratio.
- \*The untested devices were from the year 2021...
- \*Uncontrolled cross connections can lead to back pressure or siphonage events that may allow contaminants or disease causing organisms to enter the drinking water, which can cause diarrhea, nausea, cramps, and associated headaches.
- \*The population at risk was the customers of the Ralston Valley Water and Sanitation District.
- \*Alternative water sources are not necessary to be used.
- \*There are no actions consumers need to take.
- \*Ralston Valley provided documentation demonstrating the assemblies not tested in 2021 have all been tested within 90 days of there respective active date. CDPHE considers this issue resolved and no further follow up is required.
- \*Reporting compliance was achieved in March of 2022.
